



#### SCHOLARSHIP HOLDERS SELECTION PROCES


Throughout the year, the Hastor Foundation receives scholarship applications, via letters and an online form (found on the Hastor Foundation's website), from students of primary and secondary schools in Bosnia and Herzegovina. The applications comprise the applicants' contact information, short description of the applicants' socio-economic situation, as well as the information about the applicants' grades and GPA.


The evaluation of the applications is conducted once a year, in the period from February until March, and upon its completion a request form is sent to the applicants. The request form needs to be filled in and submitted together with the additional documents that demonstrate the validity of applicants' claims about their socio-economic situation and GPA. The accumulated data is entered into computer software that automatically generates the ranking list of the candidates. Afterwards, the Hastor Foundation's team visits the candidates with the highest number of points. Once the evaluation is complete, scholarships are awarded to a certain number of candidates, in accordance with the budget approved for that school year.

College students can become scholarship holders of the Hastor Foundation if the Foundation issues the Call for the Scholarship Applications for college students. The Call is issued in the period from October until November of the current year. Applications are submitted exclusively via online form, and no additional documents are required. Computer software automatically generates a ranking list based on the applicants' academic success, as well as the economic situation in their families. The candidates who are awarded the highest number of points are called for an interview with the members of the Commission for awarding scholarships.

# The 13<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Hastor Foundation

In thirteen years of continuous work, the Hastor Foundation rose to become the leading foundation in Bosnia and Herzegovina with the highest number of scholarship holders. We are especially proud to point out that we currently provide scholarships to 1.976 scholarship holders, though we certainly see these numbers going up in the following school year. Of greatest importance are also the Foundation's alumni who are now respected professionals and experts in their respective fields. The Hastor Foundation's unique mission, coupled with long-standing efforts and determination to improve BiH society is what shaped it into what it is today - one of the most recognizable foundations of its kind. During the previous 13 years, the Foundation supported more than 3.000 youths all across Bosnia and Herzegovina, aiding in their becoming successful and responsible citizens, both in their own communities and globally.

The April meeting was opened by Seid Fijuljanin, the Foundation's Managing Director, who first reminded the scholarship holders of the Foundation's values and the importance of these monthly gatherings. He told the students that they should perceive these monthly meetings as the opportunity for networking with amazing young people who are part of the Foundation, and stressed the importance of exchanging experiences and views.

The thirteenth anniversary of the Hastor Foundation's work was also an excellent opportunity to present the improved version of the Foundation's app. The app called "Moja Fondacija Hastor" was envisioned as a platform that would enable smoother communication between the Administration team, the network of volunteers, and the Supervisory team.

The app was presented by a former scholarship holder Sanel Delić, the leader of the Foundation's team of scholarship holders who worked tirelessly to develop this app. The very idea of the app was born back in 2016 when the first team of scholarship holders was created to begin working on the realization of this idea. Over the past three years, the app has been improved for its final version to be presented at the 13th anniversary. It is important to mention that this app is the result and product of the scholarship holders themselves, their wishes and tireless work; they wanted to give their own lasting contribution to the work of the Foundation and this is their legacy to all the current and future scholarship holders. Thus, for its thirteenth anniversary, the Hastor Foundation received its own app which once again proved why we are the leading foundation in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

#### HIGHLIGHTS

#### The New Version of the Hastor Foundation App Presented

By presenting the app "Moja Fondacija Hastor", the Hastor Foundation has once again confirmed that it is the leading foundation of this kind both in BiH and in the region. In the manner appropriate for the occasion, namely the marking of the thirteenth anniversary of the Foundation's existence, consistency and progress, the app was officially presented as a symbolical gift to the scholarship holders. "Moja Fondacija Hastor" is designed primarily as a platform which will connect the Administration team and the scholarship holder volunteers.

enable purpose smoother Its basic is to communication, but also to make the overall volunteering process, which is the primary principle of the Hastor Foundation, easier. With the help of this app, the Administration team, the network of volunteers, but also the team of supervisors, will all interact directly, with no intermediaries; this will make the process of recording volunteer hours and regular scholarship holders' activities much easier and faster. It is also important to mention the platform's "Monitoring" option, one of its integral components that allows for monitoring of volunteer meetings of scholarship holders across BiH via video calls. The "Moja Fondacija Hastor" platform offers an additional special option, with the purpose of establishing and nurturing connections between

all scholarship holders; this implies that the app's primary goal lies in strengthening the bonds within the Foundation itself. Namely, the app allows every user to find contact information of other scholarship holders, including primary and secondary school students, college students, and alumni.

During the April monthly meeting of college student scholarship holders, on the day when the Hastor Foundation marks its 13th anniversary, the app was officially presented by Sanel Delić, its former scholarship holder. Sanel is the leader of the team of scholarship holders who have worked tirelessly and consistently on the design, development and, eventually, the presentation of the improved version of the "Moja Fondacija Hastor" app.

In addition to all of the above, it is important to mention that this app is the result and product of the scholarship holders themselves, their wishes and tireless work; they wanted to give their own lasting contribution to the work of the Foundation. This platform will certainly be left as a legacy to all the current and future scholarship holders who will use it to do and record their activities and volunteering, and it is through this app and its concept that the work of the Foundation will be made considerably easier.

#### Teacher Ramo Receives Mozaik's Award for

#### Individual Philanthropy

On the 22nd of March, the Mozaik Foundation held a gala event at the Hotel Europe, in Sarajevo, at which select individuals and companies were awarded for their contribution to the development of the society, at the same time acknowledging all those who consciously do good or dobro, in Bosnian language. This year's DOBRO for Philanthropy award ceremony was organized as a part of the Sign up For Impact project and in cooperation with SIGN network, while the European Union and Balkan Trust for Democracy provided financial backing. The DOBRO for Philanthropy 2019 was awarded in three main categories: for corporative philanthropy, corporative volunteering and individual philanthropy.

In the 35+ age category for the individual philanthropy award, our teacher Ramo, nominated due to numerous citizens' votes, ultimately won. There are many reasons why this award found its way to teacher Ramo, and his many years of active work, mainly through the sphere of education, certainly earned him the recognition of being one of the greatest philanthropists of our society. For thirteen years already this man has been our Foundation's volunteer, making up its very core. He had helped set the first stone of this Foundation and gave it life and purpose, and during these thirteen years teacher Ramo was actively involved in our activities, tirelessly crossing many miles in search of new scholarship holders.

It is unnecessary to go into details regarding everything that this man had done for the Foundation, but it bears mentioning that it is through his character and life's work that many scholarship holders see the Foundation. Maybe it would suffice to say that a large number of our scholarship holders became part of the Hastor Foundation precisely due to the efforts of teacher Ramo.

It is enough to look at the world through his eyes, at least for a moment, in order to find out why he has dedicated his life to doing good: "As a teacher, I strove to teach children on their path to becoming grown people, and as a volunteer of the Hastor Foundation, I decided to take on the task of showing youths how to become people in the true sense of that word. Some of these lessons are: that they do not hate those who are different from them, and that they, eventually, learn to love them instead; that they, to the best of their abilities, help all those in need of help; that they acquire new knowledge, gain education and become academic citizens. These are the reasons why I have traveled hundreds of miles a day to be present at the meetings of the Foundation's scholarship holders - I wanted to show them the right path and steer them towards becoming people in the truest sense."

# THE SIXTH CYCLE OF TAKT ACADEMY SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED

With the awarding of the certificates of completion, the sixth cycle of the TAKT Academy program was officially brought to a close on the 28th of February. In the following period, the participants who received the certificates will be given a chance to find employment in Prevent Group. The TAKT Academy offers knowledge and skills that are necessary in order to work in the fashion, textile, furniture, and automotive industries. The program offers a systematic approach to tailoring the educational system in accordance with the needs of the labor market and involves learning about manufacturing and process management.

In addressing those present, the Hastor Foundation's Managing Director, Seid Fijuljanin, emphasized that some of the participants were given jobs immediately upon completing the practical training, due to having shown remarkable knowledge and abilities. The participants' mentors awarded them with certificates and wished them success in their further education and work.



# THE HASTOR FOUNDATION AND **USAID WHAM** SUCCESSFULLY CARRIED OUT THE "TRAINING FOR JOB – TRAINING TO STAY"

During the period from the 1st of April until the 31st of October, 2018, the Hastor Foundation carried out the project whose aim was to train young people and provide them with knowledge and skills needed for the labor market. The project titled "Training for Job – Training to Stay" was financed by USAID WHAM.

More than 90 people from the Bugojno Municipality area and the nearby areas received training during this period, and the 60 who completed the program most successfully were given an employment opportunity in Prevent Group company in Bugojno.

Edisa Subašić, currently employed at Prevent Step, shared her thoughts about participating in this training. "I applied to the Call and, after successfully completing the training, I was given an employment opportunity in Prevent. I am grateful for the given opportunity to gain work experience and become independent. The training organized by the Hastor Foundation and its partners helped me greatly during this entire process."

The project was carried out by the Hastor Foundation, which provides direct support to young people in BiH through its work and motivates them to become self-aware leaders through their education, work and effort, and in that way to contribute to the development of the society in general. The Hastor Foundation champions the introduction of the dual system of education, and at the same continuously cooperates with the local and international organizations active in these fields of industry.

THE HASTOR FOUNDATION AND PREVENT COMPONENTS IMPLEMENTING THE **IDEAL PROJECT**: SYNERGY OF THE INDUSTRY AND SCHOOLS IN BOSNIAN-PODRINJE CANTON GORAŽDE LEADS TO MOST ADVANCED CURRICULUM IN THE

COUNTRY

The Hastor Foundation is also recognizable for the fact that it does not base its activities solely on shortterm financial assistance to its scholarship holders. Its work and effort is focused on implementing various projects through which young, promising people, who are actually at the core of her consistent progress, will become qualified and competitive in the labor market. One such project, the idea and implementation of which are proudly supported by the Foundation, is the IDEAL project, which is the result of the synergy of business and educational institutions in BPC. Namely, in July 2019 activities with regard to developing a curriculum for the profession of "plastic worker" were finalized, thus bringing to a close the process which began last year in the Bosnian-Podrinje Canton, more precisely in Goražde. This canton received a state-of-the-art curriculum designed by international and local experts, including representatives of the industry (the plastics industry). The new school curriculum was created based on a newly-established vocations standard that features a greater number of practical classes that are to be conducted within companies, as well as fewer general knowledge classes. The curriculum will be implemented in the Secondary Vocational School "Džemal BIjedić" Goražde, beginning next school year.

"Plastics worker" is among those vocations that offer a very promising future in BiH, and the only institution that provides the needed education for it is the Secondary Vocational School "Džemal Bijedić" in Goražde.

The education process has elements of dual education which provides the students with great benefits as soon as they enroll. In addition to their mentor's support, while taking practical classes in companies the students receive meal allowance and have their transport fees covered, but also enjoy many other benefits.

The students gain general and vocational knowledge in theoretical classes at school, whereas practical classes, adjusted to the actual needs of the labor market, are held at renowned companies whose products are present across the global market.

After completing formal education based on this system, it can be rightly said that the student mastered their craft and is ready for employment.

Dženana Omanović, representative of the "PREVENT COMPONENTS" d.o.o. Goražde, talked of the significance that this curriculum's implementation has for entrepreneurs:

"The tailoring of the educational system in accordance with the needs of the labor market will allow the entrepreneurs to have access to quality employees who are ready to answer the needs of the market with minimal delay. We have to be aware of the fact that every industry is on the path towards modernization and that the demands of the market, which are greater every day, need to be met. Educational system has to follow. I believe that this curriculum will fully satisfy the needs of the plastics industry. We look forward to its implementation and hope that, in a few years' time, the

students who have decided to pursue this vocation will become our employees."

The implementation of the "IDEAL-Improving and Developing the Educational and Learning System for Plastic Workers in Bosnia and Herzegovina" is the result of the developmental partnership of the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH, "PREVENT COMPONENTS" d.o.o. Goražde and the Hastor Foundation. The partnership is established as part of the develoPPP.de program of the Federal Ministry of Economic Cooperation and Development of Germany (BMZ). The project is funded by BMZ and its private sector project partner -"PREVENT COMPONENTS" d.o.o. Goražde. All the activities pertaining to the project aid the establishment of a vocational education that is more oriented towards the needs of the labor market and increase in overall quality of this system, as well as output of a qualified workforce which is the main contributor to the country's economic development.

#### SUMMER HOLIDAYS IN THE NETHERLANDS

"Summer Holidays in the Netherlands" is one of the most prominent projects of the Hastor Foundation. It has been successfully implemented in cooperation with the Dutch partner organization Stichting Kinderhulp Bosnie for the 13th year in a row. As a part of this project, every year a group of children from underprivileged rural areas in Bosnia and Herzegovina travel to the Netherlands, where they spend twenty-one days learning about the culture and customs of this lowland country. The selection of the children is personally taken care of by teacher Ramo Hastor, together with representatives of the Dutch organization. This year, this opportunity was given to a group of twenty-six children from Živinice, Kladanj, Sapna, Teočak, Višća and Memići. Two scholarship holders of our Foundation, Džulisa Otuzbir and Ajla Drakovac, also travelled with them as guides.

This is a unique project since it gives the children who do not have the opportunity to travel outside their homeland a chance to travel and learn about completely different culture, language, customs and generally a different way of life. Designed carefully so that the children have the opportunity to experience the Dutch way of life firsthand, the project made it possible for the children to spend this three-week period in Dutch families, and as such they were accepted as regular members of the families in their households.

Given that this was a group of children between the age of 8 and 12 who had not traveled before, arriving in the Netherlands and getting to know the Dutch lifestyle was a bit of a culture shock. Of course, this reaction was natural and expected, so our scholarship holders Ajla and Džulisa tried their best to make it easier for them to adapt to the new environment.

The skillfully designed three-week program provided children with an equal amount of fun, learning and rest. Most of all, they enjoyed the activities that included everyone. At those times, full of new experiences, they would usually tell each other stories about their new families and the activities they did in the previous days.

Efteling was certainly the crown of the project for

the children, but a series of other activities marked the three-week stay in the Netherlands. They had the opportunity to try out some great playrooms, slides, zoos, swimming pools, and even showed some muscle in the city's fitness room. We also tried lottery, which particularly impressed the children. In the popular bingo game, each child received a gift, which gave them special joy. Individual activities, that is, activities with families where the children resided, were mostly about learning the Dutch language and culture. Dutch parents and their children had the freedom to devise their own plan of activities for Bosnian children, apart from the joint activities in which they all participated.

Special recognition should be given to wonderful Dutch families, members of the Kinderhulp Bosnie Foundation, without whom this project would not have been successfully implemented. Embracing children from another country, away from their families, and providing them with a home, love and all the care they need, presented a great responsibility. These families not only opened the doors of their homes to Bosnian children; moreover, they selflessly opened their hearts and brought an incredible amount of love and energy into this project. Despite cultural and language barriers, what prevailed was love and a strong desire to provide the children with an unforgettable stay in their country.





Amila Bešić is in the fourth year of law studies at University of Bihać and has been a part of the Foundation for nine years already. She lives in a small municipality of Bosanski Petrovac which is located in the southwestern part of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Her volunteerism and activism have made her stand out even in primary and secondary school, since she took part in many extra-curricular activities and joined several organizations during that time.

Amila helped carry out many projects and activities, often in collaboration with various institutions and organizations, among them being: "Školski parkić", supported by the Youth Information Agency (OIA), "Volonterizmom za bolje sutra", supported by the SHL Foundation, and "Igralište Gromača" and "Edukativne radionice sa djecom sa poteškoćama u razvoju", both of which were carried out with the help of the Mozaik Foundation.

All of these activities lead to Amila deciding to apply for the position of Youth Coordinator for Bosanski Petrovac municipality. She was ultimately chosen for the position, meaning that she also became a part of the program of projects, supported by the Council of Europe, whose aim is to strengthen undeveloped BiH municipalities which are separated by an entity-based demarcation line. With the needs of the youth in mind and through cooperation of youth coordinators from Petrovac, Drvar, and Istočni Drvar municipalities, an initiative to establish vouth organizations and offices was stated. When it comes to the Bosanski Petrovac Youth Organization, it was established in March, 2018, with the support of the aforementioned program of the Council of Europe.

This youth organization works on a voluntary basis and is separate from public institutions, governing bodies, political parties, and employers and their associations – it represents the interests of its members on economic, humanitarian, social and cultural level and stands for unity of all young people in regard to their interests. The

Organization was primarily founded with the aim of strengthening the position of youth in Bosanski Petrovac Municipality, but its Statute also states that it organizes scientific, educational, research, humanitarian, ecological, sports, and culture-related activities that concern youth, facilitates activism and volunteerism, aids preparation and implementation of projects, and collaborates with other organizations, institutions, governing bodies, and companies.

Our Amila serves as the President of the Organization, and is thus its primary representative. She is particularly proud of the successful implementation of the "Više cvijeća – manje smeća" project that took place in November, 2018 and whose aim was to raise-awareness of importance of ecology through work with children. It was carried out by her organization and supported by the Mozaik Foundation.

In the following period, the Bosanski Petrovac Youth Organization plans to carry out new projects, including the one concerning restoration of children's playground in Dževar neighborhood. Amila Bešić, its President, expresses readiness and wish to cooperate with the Hastor Foundation on future projects and activities, but also with individual scholarship holders who recognize the importance of being engaged in volunteerism and activism, the crucial principles on which the Hastor Foundation's principles rest.

## Start Me Up Competition: The First and Second Prize for the Scholarship Holders of the Hastor Foundation

Start Me Up: High School competition was held from the 18th until the 20th of January 2019. It was organized by the International Burch University and the Association of High School Students in Bosnia and Herzegovina, and the ideas of our scholarship holders Amina Madžak and Ajdin Bajrić marked the competition and brought them the first and second prize.

Our Amina's "DepresijApp" project won the award for the best business idea, whereas Ajdin's platform "Arc" won the second place.

"Depresij App" project was envisioned as a unique app that would connect an expert with a (potential) patient who is suffering from depression, thereby offering an opportunity for prevention, education, but also treatment. The conversation between an expert and person in need of counseling would be kept entirely private and discrete.

The app is conceived in the following way,

consisting of four key sections. The first section of DepresijApp is entirely educational, with all the necessary information on depression as a mental disorder, while the second contains a questionnaire in which the user inputs demographic data, and, more importantly, his or her current subjective experience. The third section is filled with different types of disorders linked with depression and presented through animated sequences. The fourth and most significant section allows the user to get in touch with an expert who will provide them with free and anonymous counseling. This allows for the issue to be examined, and users are given relevant advice and a referral for further counseling.


Arc is a platform/app that offers an easy way of finding and paying for transport services. The user, a person requiring (fast and economical) transport, opens the app to find a driver and a vehicle that best suits their needs. The app lists the location of all the service providers

in the vicinity, accompanied by other clients' reviews and all the relevant information on the service provider and their vehicle. Once the user decides on the service provider, they send their location, allowing the driver to reach them. When the user enters the vehicle, the route confirmation is sent and the money is transferred to the driver's account via e-banking. The platform allows every citizen/user a quick transport solution, regardless of the location or time. The app offers an economical solution for both users and service providers.

Another proof that creativity and dedication, together with one's wish for positive change and progress, inevitably lead to success are these accomplishments of our two young scholarship holders Amina and Ajdin, whose future still awaits.



Aris Karamustafić and His Team Are the Winners of the Prestigious Competition "STEM Youth Innovation" Held in London



Aris Karamustafić a seventeen-year-old scholarship holder of the Hastor Foundation, together with a team of students of the United World College in Mostar, partook in the prestigious STEM innovation competition, organized by BIEA (British International Education Association).

The primary purpose of this competition is designing a drone which would help and enable the protection and preservation of endangered animal species. Being inspired by the negative status of vultures in Bosnia and Herzegovina and the recent phenomenon of the extinction of the griffin vulture, as well as the inaccessibility of mined terrains in BiH, Aris's team decided to design an unmanned aerial vehicle whose crucial function would be recording the mined areas and delivering the data collected to scientists. The data would later be used for the investigation and observation of endangered animals. The primary reason to use such drones in mined areas is to eliminate the life risk, given that human intervention and the dominant role of the human factor so far would become entirely redundant, since the data would be collected via these drones.

This drone is also equipped with a wireless charging set, and its base with solar panels, and as such it would be completely independent. Aris's team passed all stages of qualifications and entered the finale of this competition, as one of the 40 best teams from the initial 1.300 which applied to this competition. The finale was held in London at the Royal Air Force Museum, consisting of three segments: the drone flight, the presentation of the idea and work, and the team evaluation; Aris's team

excelled in all three. At the very beginning of the competition, his team won the Best Display Award and Best Effort Award, despite an exceptionally tough competition comprising teams from 18 countries. They were also named the best team in the age 15-17 category. Having won these awards, at the end of this prestigious competition they were chosen as winners and given the overall grand prize of £5,000 that was donated to the school.



In the Company of Best Students in BiH – HF Scholarship Holders at the Presidency Building Reception



In December, 2018, member of Presidency of BiH, Šefik Džaferović, held a reception at the Great Hall of the Presidency Building for eight best students among all public universities in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Among the eight chosen students were two of the Hastor Foundation's scholarship holders, Maida Husnić, who studies at the Faculty of Humanities, Džemal Bijedić University of Mostar, and Jasmina Kavgić, a student at the Faculty of Economics, University of Tuzla.

After the reception, Maida and Jasmina returned home with the most positive impressions possible and have stated that for all the effort they put in during their education, they couldn't have imagined a greater honor than this one. The following paragraphs detail our scholarship holders' impressions:

Maida: "It was a particular honor for me to be given the title of one of the best eight students in all of BiH and in that way represent my University, but also the Department of Bosnian Language and Literature in particular. I would like to use this opportunity to express my gratitude to all those who have, up until know, recognized my success and the success of my colleagues, because that is what shows us that we are not alone on this path to success and that really values are appreciated and awarded. This success hides a lot of effort, hard work, sacrifices, and dedication to what I do, as well as good time management. However, I would be lying if I said that it was difficult. In spite of the difficulties we encounter, if we have truly given ourselves to what we do, success comes naturally and each obstacle is overcome more easily.

Also, I was lucky to be surrounded by the right people who made taking steps easier. In addition to friends and family, I would also mention the support of the Hastor Foundation that proved to be a great motivational factor in regard to my studying. The key realization is that we forge our own path and if we're not prepared to do something good for ourselves than we have no right to expect positive outcomes."

Jasmina: "December of 2018 was a very special month in my life. I was overjoyed when I was calling the Foundation for the second time that month to tell that I will be given a recognition for what I've accomplished in the academic field. That feeling was even stronger because of the slogan: "Education – the Choice of Winners"

The reception at the Presidency Building was, in a way, a crowning moment of my first cycle of studies, as well as a confirmation that education really does open a path to glory and victory. I am particularly proud of the fact that on that day, two out of eight of us represented the Hastor Foundation, together with teacher Ramo, which is another confirmation of how strong our Hastor Foundation family is, and how much it invests in young people and their future. It was wonderful to be among talented young people, to hear their ideas about future, share their dreams, and so become even more inspired and motivated to overcome new obstacles, and, of course, have this sense that with the Hastor Foundation we are always winners."

On the day of the reception, a clear message was sent to BH public: the hard work and effort that the young people demonstrate in the course of their education does not go unnoticed, and should be closely followed and affirmed. All other levels of government in BiH, as well as the public, have received a message that successful young people and their results are deserving of respect and special attention.

# Edvin Jarić, secondary vocational school, tomislavgrad



She has been the Hastor Foundation's scholarship holder for five years already. She spends her leisure time reading books, riding a bike, walking, and with her friends and family.



Following her childhood dreams, Larisa enrolled in the Secondary Music School in Zenica, which she also completed as the top student of the generation.

After high school, she passed the entrance exam at the Sarajevo Music Academy, at the Department of String Instruments and Guitar, with focus on the violin. She is currently a fourth-year student and is taking her final exam at the end of September.

"I've been a Hastor Foundation scholarship holder for three years. At the Foundation I volunteered on the field, worked with students, and I currently perform my duties in the administration. In addition to the financial support, I am grateful to the Hastor Foundation for every friendship that I have gained in these past three years, and there were many of them. I am especially grateful for the advice and support given to me at times when I could not make some decisions myself. I came to Sarajevo alone with my violin. I didn't have any relatives or parents with me, but thanks to the Hastor Foundation I never felt lonely. For that I thank you very much!"

Near the end of last year, our former scholarship holder and now an excellent young dentist, Mirza Murga, shocked the public with his decision to stay in his hometown, regularly left by young people and often even whole families. In the midst of all the young people and also families who are leaving BiH, this young man of great ambition made a decision to stay in Livno, popularly known as "the ghost town", as the largest number of people leaving for the countries of EU come from the municipality of the same name.

He was one of the Hastor Foundation's first scholarship holders, with teacher Ramo personally bringing him into this family, and as such he was part of the Foundation for ten years. He will be remembered as an extraordinary friend, student, mentor, and a hard-working scholarship holder. As a mentor, he would often surprise both his pupils and the Foundation's Administration team with carefully planned workshops which made the volunteering meetings he organized a special experience. What we are overjoyed to say when we talk about Mirza is the fact that even after he formally stopped being a scholarship holder, he remained the Foundation's friend and a trusty volunteer. He completed his studies at the Faculty of Dentistry in Sarajevo in September 2017, and one year later he was about to start with his own private practice in his hometown of Livno.

Making sure that young and educated people stay in Bosnia and Herzegovina is the Foundation's fundamental aim, and having an opportunity to see our former scholarship holders take bold steps towards success is something which makes us incredibly happy and proud. Mirza has the fondest memories of his time in the Foundation, and he describes it as "a pillar of support and an outstretched hand which has not only offered help but taught him many things, and also enabled him to make invaluable friendships."

# Mehmed Mehić

Mehmed was born in Bihać in August 1995; as a primary school student in Konjodor, Bužim, he meets teacher Ramo, a passer-by, whom he gives a glass of water, and in return receives from him a scholarship contract of the Hastor Foundation. This is how Mehmed became our scholarship recipient at the very beginning of the Foundation and has been an active volunteer for over thirteen years.

He graduated from the Secondary Music School in Bihać, but refers to himself as a self-taught artist who, ever since he became aware of his own self, tried to play on his keyboard at home everything he would here at any given place. Four years later, our scholarship holder graduated from the Music Academy of the University of Sarajevo in the Department of Music Theory and Pedagogy, his GPA being above 9.0. While he was still a student, he worked part-time jobs in the form of audio/video recording and being in charge of the sound system for concerts for public institutions. He also worked as a sound engineer, distributed and recorded the 10th Sarajevo Business Forum 2019, and made audio and video recordings for his own studio in collaboration with numerous celebrities. He has managed to buy equipment for his studio, which, in the future, he plans to register under the name Studio M Production.

Mehmed confirms the motto of the Hastor Foundation - "Education is the choice of winners" by working as an associate professor of guitar at the "Vila Hadžihalilović" Culture and Education Center since 2018. He previously received a full-time job as a sound engineer at Nova BH.

A great source motivation to work and study, besides in the Foundation, Mehmed has found in his wife, Azra, with whom he has been married since he was 19, and throughout all this time, this wonderful young man manages to be a good husband, student, scholarship holder and colleague. In addition to his distinct intelligence and creativity, he is also modest. For him, happiness is what we create ourselves, and how much we manage to use our potentials for what really matters.

We wish Mehmed much happiness and success in the future, and that he remains as creative and ambitious as he has been so far.
