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## FOREWORD



Reflecting on the work and achievements of the Hastor Foundation in the period covered by this Annual Report reminded me of how I have followed its unparalleled progress and growth for the past 10 years, initially as one of its scholarship recipients, then as an employee, and now as the director. The guiding principle of the Hastor Foundation are the words of our founders: that the light of kindness never goes out if we share our flame with others. The years that have passed are proof that this light has truly never dimmed down but has grown with each new young person who found support in the Hastor Foundation. It is incredible to see this flame continue to grow every time it reaches those who need it most, and this is a sight that the Hastor Foundation has had the opportunity to witness for 17 years.

The Annual Report before you will confirm that the Hastor Foundation is the largest educational foundation in the region, as evidenced by the number of our scholarship recipients, which grows year by year the amount of annual scholarships, scholarships throughout all 12 months of the year with the possibility of a 13th bonus scholarship. In 17 years of continuous work and dedication, we have awarded almost 24,000 scholarships and, together with our scholarship recipients, contributed more than 1,700,000 volunteer hours. We are particularly proud of the last figure, as it represents 1,700,000 hours during which the most beautiful human values were instilled in our scholarship recipients, where their skills and knowledge developed, and where they contributed to the construction of a better society in Bosnia and Herzegovina. In addition to material support, mentorship, as the most specific form of volunteering, the Hastor Foundation provides its scholarship recipients with an opportunity for personal growth, development, and progress. It enables them to acquire skills not taught in school and pass on their knowledge and experiences to younger generations.

As in all previous years, our focus remains primarily on our scholarship recipients and finding ways to increase their numbers and provide support and financial assistance, as well as opportunities for learning, volunteering, and personal development. Our scholarship recipients are our greatest motivation, so we strive daily to create content that will be beneficial to them and ensure the transfer of knowledge and positive values from older to younger scholarship recipients. All of this, of course, would not be possible without what sets the Hastor Foundation apart from other educational foundations in the region – volunteering, which is our most important epithet and the best reflection of what we do. Inspired by this fact, we have actively worked in the previous period to create an even more purposeful, attractive, and high-quality volunteering model to allow our scholarship recipients to develop in various fields while doing good for their community. In an effort to share the positive stories that are constantly emerging within the Hastor Foundation and have been accumulated over its many years of existence, we have launched the Hastor Foundation Podcast. We have decided to share these positive stories in this way and inspire other young people to work on themselves and do good for others.

The Hastor Foundation provides assistance to students from their early years in elementary school, guides them through their university studies, and assists them in securing their first jobs. ## SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION PROCESS



The Hastor foundation is accepting applications for scholarships by elementary and high-school students in Bosnia and Hezegovina throughout the year, both in writing and electronically (with an online form on web-page of The Hastor Foundation). The applications consist of applicants' contact, a short description of the socio-economical conditions that the applicants are living in, and information about the achieved success in school. Processing of the received application is done once a year, in the period of February/March, after which applicants are sent a request that they need to fill out together with supporting documentation that can testify to the stated economic situation and achieved school success. Collected data is entered into the software that automatically creates a list of candidates. After assesment, scholarships are awarded to a certain number of candidates depending on the budget for the given school year.



Students can become scholarship recipients of The Hastor Foundation if the foundation announces a public competition for the admission of new students. The public competition is announced at the end of the year. An application for the public competition is done exclusively online. Software automatically creates a ranking based on the success of the candidates in college and based on the economic situation in the family. Candidates with the largest number of points are invited to an interview with the members of the commission for selection of scholarship recipients.



## > The signing of the scholarship contracts with studentscholarship holders of the Hastor Foundation for the school year 2022/23

One of the more important activities for the Hastor Foundation is surely the signing of scholarship contracts with students-scholarship holders which was done at the beginning of the 2022/2023 school year. The Hastor Foundation is one of the few that provides scholarships to pupils and students from all over Bosnia and Herzegovina over all 12 months of the year, and therefore, the signing of the contracts with elementary and high school students was a long process which included going to many cities and places in our country.

We can proudly say that pupils and students from almost all of Bosnia and Herzegovina receive the scholarship of the Hastor Foundation. Each of these cities has its representatives, diligent students who are to be proud scholarship holders of the Hastor Foundation in the following year. By signing the contracts, scholarship holders undertake to be diligent and exemplary students and strive to have empathy for other people from their surroundings. In that way, they all learn at an early age the importance of helping those in need, and that is one of the most important objectives of the Hastor Foundation. In addition to that, student scholarship holders will have the opportunity to spend their volunteer hours with their mentors by talking about numerous topics about current events that are important. Therefore, every student will have a mentor who will be their support throughout the activities in the Hastor Foundation, but also throughout their education.

In November of 2022, by signing the scholarship agreement, the Hastor Foundation, together with its scholarship students, opened the first page of another new book, which, like all the previous ones, will undoubtedly be filled with new and inspiring stories.

More than 500 student-scholarship holders signed the contracts, and among them, there were students who have been scholarship holders for 16 years which goes to show that the Hastor Foundation remains by its scholarship holders until the end of their educational path. A true example of this is the story of our scholarship holder Semra Islamović for whom this was her 14th scholarship contract.



I have been a scholarship holder of the Hastor Foundation since 2008. Then, being only eight years old, I still had not been aware of the fact how lucky I really was and what all that meant for me, my parents, and my further education. From the very beginning, the Foundation has been a tremendous source of support for me, and every time I reached out to them, they were always ready to offer assistance and help, both to me and to all other scholarship recipients. I met a lot of people through my volunteer work, made friends, became more independent and more creative, and more ready to work in a team. I exchanged many different experiences both with children and my mentor colleagues.



## Scholarship contracts with 30 new scholarship recipients accepted as part of the Competition for gifted students signed

Each year, the Hastor Foundation opens its doors to the new hopes of the Bosnian society. At the end of 2022, based on the rules and criteria of the Hastor Foundation, a competition for the allocation of scholarships for full-time students who enrolled for the first time in the academic year 2022/2023 was announced. The students who had the right to apply were the full-time students who were studying at accredited higher education institutions in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

It was a great pleasure to see the interest of the students in applying for a Hastor Foundation scholarship increasing year in and out. This number is the best testimony to the fact that the Hastor Foundation has successfully grown over the past 17 years into a community that gathers young people who are helpful members of society and contribute to it by volunteering in various ways.

The scholarship selection committee has chosen 30 of those who stood out with their volunteering activities and socially useful work, and simultaneously, they also maintained outstanding academic results. What should be emphasized is that by increasing the number of scholarship holders every year, the Hastor Foundation supports not only individuals but also the entire community.


The prizes for the winners in all categories were as follows: 300.00 KM for the first place, 200.00 KM for the second place, and 100.00 KM for the third place.

In the Hastor Foundation, we have many such stories, and we've chosen to present them through the currently most popular new medium - Podcasts. Through the stories of our current and former scholarship holders, we aim to provide inspiration and motivation to young individuals who are facing significant life challenges, with the hope that the inspirational stories of our guests will offer additional support and guidance in their personal development.

In the first season of the podcast, we hosted numerous successful young individuals, scholarship recipients, and alumni of the Hastor Foundation, who have excelled in various fields. Through conversations with them, we covered many useful and interesting topics, as well as shared positive and inspirational stories that can serve as guidance for young people in their process of maturation, progress, and finding opportunities for volunteering, student engagement, internships, employment, and more. Since the greatest driving force of the Hastor Foundation lies in its current and former scholarship holders, the podcast was realized thanks to this collective strength. They actively participated in conceptualizing, planning, and producing the podcast. Serving as the hosts of the podcast are two valued scholarship holders of the Hastor Foundation: Dženana Zulum, a student at the Faculty of Political Sciences, University of Sarajevo, and Amina Zorlak, a student at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Sarajevo.



## **Commencement of a New Volunteering Model Implementation**

Seeking to provide more assistance and support to our scholarship recipients while listening to their needs and ideas, we have actively worked on creating a new volunteering model within the Hastor Foundation in the recent period. The implementation of this new volunteering model began in September, and it not only introduces new volunteering activities but also enriches the experience with specialized clubs. This way, our scholarship recipients, including elementary and high school students, will benefit in multiple ways. During volunteer meetings with their mentors, they will have the opportunity to acquire knowledge and skills that will be useful in their daily lives. Through collaborative volunteer actions with their mentors, they will be motivated from a young age to perform good deeds, promote positive human values, and engage in meaningful activities in their local communities. Moreover, they will have the opportunity to deepen their knowledge of school subjects and excel academically through specialized clubs focusing on different subjects and fields. The main task of these clubs will be to provide inclusive workshops and classes to scholarship recipients who are struggling with particular school subjects. Those who are exceptionally gifted and talented in certain areas will have the opportunity to further develop their skills by working with mentor scholarship recipients who will lead our specialized clubs.

In order to further improve this type of volunteer engagement of scholarship holders, the Hastor Foundation, in cooperation with numerous experts from various fields, organized training for students who, during the next academic year, will be in charge of improving the volunteer engagement of student mentors and will have the role of mentor coordinator. The training for mentor coordinators was held by experts in the fields of psychology, pedagogy, education and rehabilitation, which tried to include all the important branches of science that specialize in working with children of primary and secondary school age. The task of mentor coordinators is to transfer the acquired knowledge to other mentors and to be supportive at every moment of their mentoring process, with which we want to ensure that every hour spent working and volunteering with our scholarship holders is as high quality. and as purposeful as possible, leaving a significant mark on the development of all our scholarship holders.





With this model of volunteering, we want to help students develop their personality, work on themselves, create their dreams and recognize their skills in order to become more self-aware and responsible members of Bosnian society in the future. The new model of volunteering is not only a significant step for the Hastor Foundation, its work and mission, it is also an extremely important step towards creating a better and more promising future for our country, which makes us especially happy and motivates us to continue working on education and improving the skills and knowledge of future generations.

## > Summer Vacation in the Netherlands 2023

In addition to a multitude of successful projects, the Hastor Foundation can proudly showcase the project "Summer Vacation in the Netherlands," which it carries out with great pleasure each year in collaboration with the Dutch organization "Stichting Kinderhulp Bosnië." The idea of the project is to provide children from rural areas with a disadvantaged socio-economic status the opportunity to visit the Netherlands, forge lifelong friendships, and gain memorable experiences. In the current year, the project was implemented in June, and 28 children from Kaćuni near Busovača, Opara near Novi Travnik, and Novi Travnik had the opportunity to visit the beautiful tulip country.

Given the large number of applications received, the administration of the Hastor Foundation faced the challenging task of selecting the scholarship holders who would travel to the Netherlands. After careful consideration, we entrusted this role to our scholarship holders Amila Glamočak and Edna Porča, who eagerly took on the role of accompanying our young travelers.

The days spent in the land of tulips were very exciting for the children, as well as for our scholarship holders Amila and Edna. Through my hard work and belief in myself, I have achieved many significant successes. Football as football represents something unique to me. I have to admit that I really enjoy every moment when I'm on the field. When I became a scholarship holder of the Hastor Foundation, I knew that something new was coming into my life. I learned first of all how to be useful to my community, but also to society. I enriched my vocabulary and became a more communicative person. ## The artistic paths of our scholarship holder Lamija Šišić

Fourteen-year-old Lamija Šišić is a scholarship student who makes us proud again and again because of her work and success. She is currently in the eighth grade of primary school and the fifth grade of primary music school. In addition to violin and solfeggio lessons, Lamija also participates in rehearsals with the orchestra, and she is also excellent at painting, so she ventured to attend a painting school and an art colony. She is the state violin champion in classical music. As a young talent of Bosnia and Herzegovina, she played with the Mostar Symphony Orchestra. She is a participant in many festivals and solo concerts of a humanitarian nature, for the purpose of promoting art. She points out that one of her favourite performances is last year's classical music concert of a humanitarian nature, which she held with her sister at the Bosnian Cultural Centre in Sarajevo in the

month of May in memory and honour of the innocent victims of the Sarajevo Canton. This is not the only act of showing humanity and nurturing the true values of our scholarship student - Lamija recently donated her hair to children with cancer, showing her maturity and willingness to show solidarity with others and to recognize other people's worries and problems. All of these values are embedded in the core of the existence of the Hastor Foundation, and we are more than proud that our scholarship holders convey and demonstrate them at every opportunity. Lamija says about the Hastor Foundation as an important part of her educational journey:

## The inspiring and amazing path to success of our karateka Ajla Kahrić

Ajla is a primary school student with impeccable grades and outstanding achievements in sports activities. At first, she joined a folklore group at the age of five, but her attention was soon captured by the sport that today represents her greatest joy and brings great satisfaction - karate. Her first competition took place in 2019, and just two years later, in 2021, she won participation in the national championship, thanks to her placement at the federal championship, which was followed by a number of important competitions, among which the Balkan Championship stands out. Her path to success continues and she soon achieved placements in many important competitions, among which one of the most prestigious tournaments in the Balkans stands out - Ilidža Open, where she won a gold medal, which she is particularly proud of, as well as the great results achieved this year: gold medal at the Balkan Championship in Sarajevo, third place at

the National Championship, etc. It would be difficult to count all the medals and awards that Ajla won in an extremely short period of time, so we can only imagine how much sacrifice, effort and discipline her path to these successes required. Ajla is truly the best of the best. Finally, we recorded another sentence from our interlocutor, where she emphasizes the importance of the Hastor Foundation in her life:

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Thanks to the Foundation, I made new friends and with the help of the scholarship, I pay the membership fee for sports and competitions myself, depending on whether I have these expenses during that month.



## Competitive successes of Amer Šabić

That our Foundation is a treasure trove of young talents dedicated to science, volunteering, as well as numerous extracurricular activities, is proven by our nineteen-year-old scholar Amer Šabić, who comes from Ključ. He graduated from the "Professor Omer Filipović" Mixed High School in Ključ. Amer Šabić won first place in the school competition in mathematics, at the same level he also achieved first place in physics, after which he qualified for the cantonal competition (field A – mechanics and thermodynamics), where he also won first place. His path to success continues with his participation in the federal physics competition. In addition to the above, he also won first place in the school competition in informatics and first place in the cantonal competition in the same subject. Amer is the best proof of how important the role of a mentor is for all our scholarship recipients!

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I discovered my talent and love for subjects such as mathematics, physics and informatics back in primary school when I started competing and from the 6th grade, I achieved significant results in these subjects. I prepared with the help of my mentors, who are largely responsible for my success. I am happy to be one of the pupils in her group and I like spending time at the meetings, where we covered and are still covering many interesting topics from which I learned a lot.



#### Neđada Ramić - athletics champion in various disciplines

Day by day, our scholarship recipients show remarkable progress and achieve high goals under the auspices of the Hastor Foundation. A clear indicator of exceptional ambition can be seen in the success of the young scholar Neđada Ramić, a student of the Faculty of Health Studies of the University of Sarajevo, majoring in Physiotherapy. As Neđada points out, athletics has always been her first love since childhood and she was always known for her energy. Despite certain challenges, Neđada made her dreams come true with a great deal of enthusiasm. Already in the first grade of high school, she showed incredible independence and courage when she decided to compete and won third place, which allowed her to go to the finals. She continued her journey and proudly won the bronze medal. She started her career by realizing her first dreams, creating foundations for new ones as a member of the AK Sarajevo club. She became the champion in 400 meters, 800 meters, cross country, relays 4x400 meters and 4x100 meters, all-around, where she was the senior champion two years in a row, and in many international competitions.

Athletics helped me to develop my character, to improve my physical abilities and to learn that the biggest battle is fought in the head, and that is the battle of man with himself. Through sports, I became interested in the study of injuries and rehabilitation, which is why I enrolled in Physiotherapy. The Hastor Foundation was by my side throughout my education. I have been a scholarship recipient of the Hastor Foundation for eleven years and I am most grateful for the support and additional motivation to achieve the best possible results both in the academic field and outside of it. Along with volunteering, I also gained a lot of knowledge and skills, as well as many friends and mentors who will always remain in my memory. The Hastor Foundation has opened many doors for me, helped me to constantly evolve, both as a student who studies and as a person who strives to be better every day, and I am extremely grateful for that.



## Amin Lulić – a boy from the world of computer wonders

Childhood dreams have enormous value if growing up is accompanied by effort and the desire to achieve them. The Hastor Foundation encourages its scholarship recipients every day to follow their dreams and strive for their realization. One of them is fourteen-year-old Amin Lulić, who comes from Cazin. In addition to regular studying and schoolwork, Amin likes to spend his free time programming. He participated in competitions in mathematics, physics, and computer science. In the past school year, he won first place in school competitions in the aforementioned subjects. Although he likes to spend his free time doing tasks in physics and mathematics, the special nature of his relationship with computer science was also shown in competitions. Namely, he won first place in the municipal computer science competition and thus once again showed his commitment to his goals, which he had already set out, even though he is only a primary school student.

Since both of my parents are unemployed, the Hastor Foundation helps them and me by financing my education. It gives me boundless motivation to study even more and improve in what I love. The foundation shows its scholarship holders the true values that I try to build in myself and thus present them to the world by my own example.

In the future, Amin plans to study at the Faculty of Information Technologies, where, as he points out, he will try to explore the depths of programming and acquire as many skills as possible so that he can later apply them in his work. In these years, he wants to lay a good foundation for the knowledge that has yet to be acquired. With his successes, he wants to repay his parents and the Foundation for all the support they provide him.



## Hamza Turulja - one of the best young athletes in Bosnia and Herzegovina

Bosnia and Herzegovina can boast of numerous sports talents whose successes show that even small countries can be an inexhaustible source of extremely successful athletes. One of the best young athletes in Bosnia and Herzegovina is precisely our scholarship recipient Hamza Turulja, who has long since started to string his successes in the field of Bosnian karate.

Hamza is a third-year student at the Faculty of Sports and Physical Education in Sarajevo, and in recent years he has focused his energy on karate, a sport that, he says, fulfils him in a special way. He currently holds the title of master black belt for the third day, is a representative of Bosnia and Herzegovina and a seven-time national champion in fighting. In addition, Hamza is also a silver medallist at the Under-21 World Championship in Santiago, Chile in 2019 and a silver medallist at

the World Youth League in the junior competition. He is the recipient of numerous awards, and in 2019 he was chosen as the best young sportsman of Bosnia and Herzegovina. He says that on his academic and sports journey, he has the Hastor Foundation by his side, which cheers him on every day. He emphasizes that this community of successful young people is very important to him, because in it he finds inspiration to work every day to be successful and to reach the best version of himself. This year was the most successful in his sports career as he won third place at the Mediterranean Games in Algeria, second place at the World University Games in Turkey, first place at the World Series A in Indonesia and fifth place at the European Championship.

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All these results would not have been possible without help and support. With my greatest support, parents and coaches and individual institutions, I would single out my Hastor Foundation. Given that all these competitions require a lot of money, and the state, unfortunately, does not support athletes enough, the scholarship from the Hastor Foundation was a great and significant help in financing the trip and the competition. Of course, this support is not only financial, the Hastor Foundation has always been there to help, support, encourage and give useful advice. Given that even before coming to the Hastor Foundation I loved volunteering and that I volunteered in a migrant children's camp, participated in a fashion show for the inclusion of children and people with disabilities, and organized sports events, through the Foundation I continued to do good, gained a certain continuity and continued to constantly remind himself how important it really is to help others. I would also like to single out the fact that I met so many wonderful young and successful people through the Foundation, so I can say that we are really one big family in the true sense of the word, says Hamza.

## **Aleksandra Đukić**

Volunteering fills me emotionally because I know that I am giving a small part of myself that means a lot to others. I believe that with my activism and social involvement, I help the entire Bosnian society, I show that I care about the country where I was born and that I do not want to leave it, but to actively participate in building a better state that will welcome some new generations of young people. The Hastor Foundation has been actively with me for more than a year, and all the while, I look at it as a form of support that I needed on my academic journey. When many doors closed to me, the Hastor Foundation opened its doors and helped me, not only financially but also through the support I feel every day. I have made acquaintances with other young people who have the same or similar interests as me, and I consider these acquaintances extremely important, and I firmly believe that they will remain even after the end of my formal education.

#### **Emrah Tepić**

Entrepreneurship, commitment, willingness to work and dedication to volunteer activities are just some of the virtues possessed by our scholarship holders. Evidence for all of the above is the long-term scholar Emrah Tepić. Given that he has been completely blind since birth, he was constantly faced with various forms of discrimination and prejudice. Despite this, he never got discouraged and always went after his luck, and is currently a master's student at the Faculty of Political Science.

Our scholarship student Emrah went through a difficult development path, partly due to the established perception of society and the numerous prejudices he faced during his education. However, Emrah found his support and great support in the Hastor Foundation, where he has been a scholarship holder for more than six years. For him, the Hastor Foundation is an extremely important part of his life because it has always been there for him and his family.



I see the Hastor Foundation as one big family and another house. It played a big role in my life. Thanks to the Hastor Foundation, my confidence has improved, and I have gained an optimistic outlook on life. I hereby thank our Hastor Foundation for making us winners, great and successful people. It is always there for us and accompanies us throughout our whole lives, said Emrah.

Emrah points out that through the concept of the Hastor Foundation, he actually got to know volunteering and that those volunteer hours were a springboard for further volunteering, which is why he became a member of other associations such as the Association for the Blind of Sarajevo Canton, the Association "Dajte nam šansu" ("Give us a chance"), the Association "Samostalan korak" ("An independent step") and the Student Support Office of the University of Sarajevo. Emrah has firmly decided to dedicate his life to doing the best he can for others and is happy to be part of a big family – the Hastor Foundation.

## Aida Mujčin

Aida comes from Sarajevo and is a fourth-year student at the Faculty of Medicine at SSST University. In addition to her love for science and medicine, she loves art and photography and is a third-year student of the Department of Graphic Design and Multimedia at Burch International University. Although science and art are two different fields, she is able to maintain a balance and remain open to new life challenges. She holds the position of president of the MEDICA association, and her activities include humanitarian actions and educational seminars, as well as the SSST Med ReCon scientific and research conference.

She enjoys photography and has been doing it for many years. In addition to college and membership in the Hastor Foundation, she started her own small business and is engaged in photographing weddings and various events, plays volleyball, and reads books, and most of all she likes to spend time with her family.



I would say that I am a responsible, persistent, and cheerful person. My love for volunteering dates back to elementary school, as a child my favourite thing in the world was the volunteer accreditation, which I always proudly and responsibly carried. Now, years later, I had the honour of being someone's role model and positive wind at my back. I found the greatest source of motivation for volunteering in the Hastor Foundation. In the beginning, I volunteered with scholarship students in elementary school, and my goal was for them to come out of each social gathering richer for something, whether it was knowledge, skills, or critical thinking. Now I'm in the graphic design team and I'm overjoyed because I'm doing what I love, and I can express my creativity and realize an idea.

She points out that the opportunities offered by the Hastor Foundation to young people are extraordinary and are certainly small steps towards a great and better future for all of us. Aida believes that the Hastor Foundation also provides us with the opportunity to have a positive impact on our community. The very idea of the Foundation, which encourages ambitious young people to make a change, has always been and will remain, as she says, very important to her.

#### **Omer Muminović**

Omer Muminović comes from Teočak and has been a scholarship holder of the Hastor Foundation for two years. He graduated from the Behram Bey madrasa in Tuzla with honours, after which he enrolled in the Department of Economics and International Business at the Sarajevo University School of Science and Technology (SSST). In his spare time, he enjoys reading, writing, and going out into nature, and when his duties permit, he likes to watch the new episode of the quiz "Millionaire". Omer's volunteer path starts from his native Teočak, where for a time he held the position of president of the Teočak Municipality Youth Council, and after enrolling in madrasa, he began to be active in the Tuzla Community Foundation in the "Youth Bank" program. After entering the faculty, he continued his volunteer work at the "Izvor nade" ("Source



of Hope") Foundation and the "Mladi za mir" ("Youth for peace") Association, where he gained rich experience and learned how to unite and repair, rather than divide and destroy, the common heritage and cultural treasures of Bosnia and Herzegovina. He says that all this helped him become part of the Hastor Foundation, which brings together young people from all over the country who share the same or similar interests. In the past year, he was on a student exchange in the USA as part of the "Global UGRAD Student Exchange Program" at the University of Houston-Victoria in Texas as the only student from Bosnia and Herzegovina who passed the demanding selection process for this program. Our scholarship holder continued his volunteering in the USA, in the "Meals on Wheels South Texas" organization, where he helps pack and distribute meals for socially vulnerable people, which shows how much he cares about working to change society and the community with his small steps.

In addition to the Hastor Foundation, Amina also volunteers in the Association "Žena, majko, sestro" ("Woman, Mother, Sister") and the Association "Osmijeh nade" ("Smile of Hope"). In the meantime, she became part of the Hastor Foundation family. This year she graduated from the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine in Sarajevo and thus fulfilled her childhood dream. She is a great perfectionist, and in her spare time she likes to read books, especially in the field of psychology. She started her volunteer journey by volunteering at the Hastor Foundation, and then she combined her free time and her love for animals and volunteering into one perfect whole that now fills her life. In her third year of college, she started volunteering at a veterinary station in

He is a member of the vocal-instrumental ensemble "Oskar Danon", during which he performed a festive concert on the occasion of the 120th anniversary of the existence of the Sarajevo Synagogue, and at the recent Guitar United international competition, he won first prize and received a registration fee for the "Transylvania"



International Guitar Festival" held in the city of Cluj -Napoca in Romania. One of the countless useful experiences he gained as a scholarship holder of the Hastor Foundation is volunteering. In his spare time, he enjoys cooking and has directed his volunteering in that direction and has been a volunteer at the Restaurant dobre volje (good will) at the non-profit organization Pomozi.ba for two years. He says that this volunteering gives him immeasurable satisfaction every day, and he volunteers as an assistant to the head chefs. In addition, he points out how useful and interesting the educational meetings he led as a mentor with a group of high school students from Čelić were. Of all the activities he had as part of the Hastor Foundation, he particularly emphasizes volunteer work with children who have visual impairments.

The most valuable experience which Hastor Foundation gave me is volunteering with children that have partial or complete vision impairment. Through that volunteering I saw their potential, abilities and worked on their development. Thanks to getting to know them, I realized how meaningful it is that every one of us "grows" in motivating and safe surroundings, with support and motivation. Also, they showed me that disability isn't something which can be a bordering obstacle if we have someone who believes in us, who supports us and further guides us. After all of this I can freely say that my biggest motivation for regular activity in society is helping others in which I see the biggest beauty and inspiration for volunteer work, says Andrej.

Andrej decided to weave his love for music into his volunteering, considering it an excellent way to improve children's learning abilities, creativity, and fine motor development.

## Samra Đuderija

Samra Đuderija was born in Sarajevo, where she still lives today. She graduated from the Jezero High School of Medicine, majoring in Pediatric Nurse - Technician. She continued her formal education in the field of medicine by enrolling in the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Sarajevo. She points out that she chose this course because of her desire to help and make things easier for people and to restore their hope for a better tomorrow. As she is one of the best students at this faculty, already during her studies she was chosen as a demonstrator at the Department of Medical Microbiology and Parasitology, for which she points out that the Hastor Foundation is also responsible. Because



she loves children, she regularly volunteers at the "Al Isra" kindergarten. Looking at children, she realizes and understands how much love there really is between them, regardless of colour, class, or religion. It is probably Samra's escape from reality, from everything that is happening in the world. Children have the purest heart, and they remind her, as she says, to keep hers that way. Looking at them, she got the desire to be part of a generation that will work for a better future for all children. About volunteering in the mentioned kindergarten and the role of the Hastor Foundation, Samra states:

I knew about volunteering even before I became a scholarship holder, but I had absolutely no idea where to start. I needed support and guidance, in short, I needed the Hastor Foundation. The foundation made me more responsible, more open, more dexterous and gave me the most important thing, support for my further future. It taught me to be a better person, to respect others and to always be a guiding hand for younger people. I try to present her in the best light, I tell my friends about her, and I present only one part of what she does for us.

## Ajla Vrebo

The foundation plays a significant role in Ajla's life. Through her years of volunteering, she saw the Foundation as a guardian assigned to her because she was a hardworking and exemplary child. That same guardian still follows her closely and gives her motivation.

She became familiar with the concept of volunteering after becoming part of the Hastor Foundation family, and it became part of her daily routine, and she became a member of various non-governmental organizations, one of which is the "Bravo" Organization, where she holds the roles of a member of the Board of Directors and a project assistant.



I have been volunteering at the Hastor Foundation since the fifth grade of elementary school. I will remember my first meetings with my mentor Belma, with whom I am still in contact today. When I became a mentor myself, I knew what I wanted to achieve - to transfer as many positive experiences as possible to the group. #### Vedad Huseinbašić






